



MILITARY ELIGIBILITY

SAN ANTONIO READY TO WORK PILOT PROGRAM INCLUDES BEXAR COUNTY RESIDENTS CONNECTED WITH THE MILITARY

Effective May 1, 2023, Military-connected residents of Bexar County that otherwise meet the Ready to Work eligibility requirements may participate in the program. For this purpose, “**Military-connected**” means:

- Active-duty service members transitioning to civilian life within 12 months of separation;
- Active-duty military spouses and dependents 18 and older (18-26 for dependent children);
- Reservists and National Guard members, spouses, and dependents 18 and older (18-26 for dependent children); and
- Veterans (including disabled veterans, honorably and dishonorably discharged veterans), spouses and dependents 18 and older (18-26 for dependent children).

Effective May 1, 2023, “household income” excludes wages of active-duty service members transitioning to civilian life within 12 months of separation.

Please provide the following Military-connected documentation for eligibility verification: Military ID, DEERS enrollment, DD214, DD215, DD256, National Guard Bureau Form (NGB), Hazelwood Act documentation, Driver’s License with Veteran’s designation, or VA-issued ID card.
